It was inspiring to experience mathematicians from around the world and various career stages supporting each other.

Among the many indicators of the health and vitality of our AMS community were generous contributions from members and friends that established new prizes, awards, and named endowed funds: Elias M. Stein Prizes for Analysis, Expository Writing, and Mentorship; an additional Edmund Landau Undergraduate Opportunity Award; the Catherine A. Roberts Fund for the Next Generation; the David and Helen Leighton Fund for Young Scholars Programs; and the Robert L. Griess, Jr. and Min Zhong Fund supporting the AMS's mission to advance research in the mathematical sciences and connect the mathematical community.

The mathematical community will also benefit from several donor bequests to the AMS that arrived last year. We honor these donors in the Thomas A. Fiske Society, which celebrates their ongoing legacies of support to the AMS mission.

With funding from the Simons Foundation and our generous donors, we provided travel grants for under-

graduate, graduate, and early-career mathematicians, and we continued to provide grants to faculty at Primarily Undergraduate Institutions to support and enhance research and collaboration.

Additionally, donors supported AMS work to foster a more inclusive environment for all mathematicians by supporting fellowships and scholarships for talented scholars and students from traditionally underrepresented groups and regions. And, at the heart of our mission, we highlighted important and timely research through our journals, publications, and MathSciNet® database, made possible by donors as well as thousands of peer reviewers from around the world. For all who have contributed to the mathematical community in these invaluable ways, you have our heartfelt gratitude.

Looking ahead, we are excited that Dr. John Meier will join the AMS as our ninth Executive Director in July 2024. I know the mathematical community will benefit from his vision and leadership, just as the AMS is supported by the collaboration and goodwill of its members. Together, we can accomplish great things for mathematics.

Named Endowed Funds

The American Mathematical Society offers donors the opportunity to establish named endowed funds at the AMS. These endowed funds support research and the mathematical community for future generations while commemorating a family member, colleague, or mentor. (The number in brackets indicates the year the fund was created.) In 2023, three new endowed funds were established.

The Catherine A. Roberts Fund for the Next Generation

Established in 2023 by an anonymous donor in honor of Catherine A. Roberts, former Executive Director of the AMS, the Fund resides within the Next Generation Fund, which supports early career mathematicians.

The David and Helen Leighton Fund for Young Scholars Programs

Established in 2023 by Tom Leighton and Bonnie Berger in memory of David and Helen Leighton, the Fund resides within the Epsilon Fund, which supports mathematics education beyond the traditional classroom for mathematically-talented youths.

The Robert L. Griess, Jr. and Min Zhong Fund

Established in 2023 by Robert L. Griess, Jr. and Min Zhong, the Fund supports the AMS' mission to advance research in the mathematical sciences and connect the mathematical community.

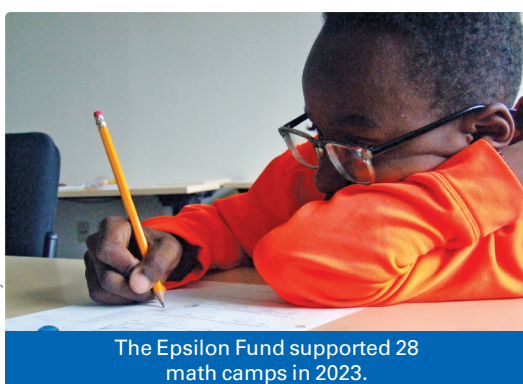

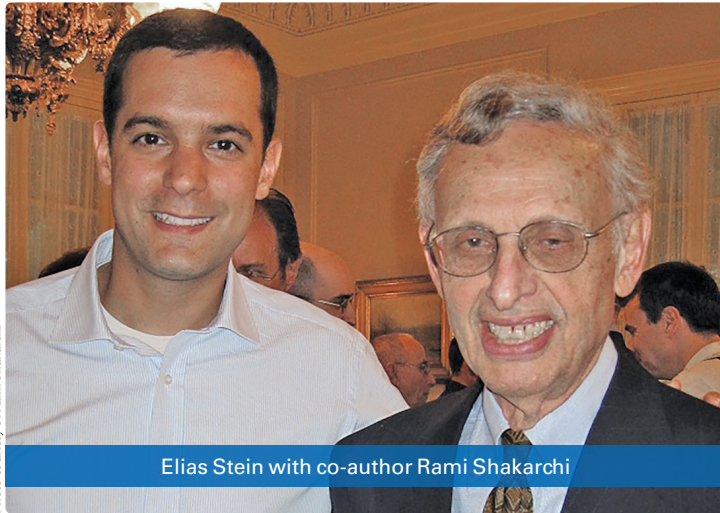

Highlight on the Elias M. Stein Prize Fund

Elias M. Stein's extraordinary legacy as a researcher, writer, and mentor inspired the creation of three new AMS prizes in 2023. The Elias M. Stein Prize Fund supporting the awards, given once every three years beginning in 2023, was made possible by the generosity of his colleagues, students, collaborators, and friends.

The **Elias M. Stein Prize for New Perspectives in Analysis** is awarded for the development of groundbreaking methods in analysis which demonstrate promise to revitalize established areas or create new opportunities for mathematical discovery.

The **Elias M. Stein Prize for Transformative Exposition** is awarded for a written work or works, such as a book, survey, or exposition, that transforms the mathematical community's understanding of the subject or reshapes the way it is taught.

The **Elias M. Stein Mentoring Award** recognizes mathematicians who have demonstrated a sustained commitment to the training and advancement of future generations of mathematicians.
